

Marine Institute Named Finalist for Distinction in Innovation Award

The Marine Institute was named a top three finalist for the Distinction in Innovation Award, awarded by the Department of Innovation Trade and Rural Development. The announcement was made by the Honourable Trevor Taylor at the 2008 Export and Innovation Awards luncheon, held at the Fairmont on April 18.

The Distinction in Innovation Award recognizes an individual or group that makes an outstanding contribution to advancing the province's innovation culture. The 2008 recipient was C-CORE. Also in the top three nominations was Genesis Group Inc.
