Duties

- All tasks required to operate, navigate and maintain *Trinity Pride* as seaworthy, in good running order, safe and reliable.
- Ensuring *Trinity Pride* is kept clean and tidy – especially those areas that are used by, or visible to passengers.
- Ensuring boat safety briefings in accordance with Transport Canada requirements are given to passengers and crew on each ferry crossing.
- Providing services in support of the Trust's activities between *Trinity Pride*'s arrival and departure times at both the Trust's Mary's Harbour and Battle Island locations. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, loading of passenger luggage, moving of the Trust's goods between locations, other tasks that can be accomplished between scheduled ferry times or requested by the Trust's Manager at Battle Harbour, or Visitor Information Supervisor at Mary's Harbour.
- Remain in Battle Harbour nightly in case emergency use of *Trinity Pride* is required.
- Other specified tasks as identified by the Trust's representative relevant to any of the above.
