## ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

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- A. Applicants must be second- to fourth-year students enrolled in a Deck Officer/Nautical Science Cadet program or Navigation Officers planning to upgrade nautical certification.
- B. A complete application must be e-mailed by, or posted no later than **September 16, 2022** to the **Company of Master Mariners of Canada Foundation** at the address below. Applications must include a completed, signed **Application Form** and the following:

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Autobiographical Letter describing applicant's educational history, marine experience, career and vocational aspirations.
2. One-page budget outlining applicant's anticipated income and expenses for the period of study.
3. Two letters of reference: one from the Master or Chief Officer of a vessel on which you've sailed. The other reference need not be associated with your marine experience.

**Note:** For current 2nd Year students who did not obtain a first sea phase due to the COVID-19 restrictions, they may submit a reference from a Nautical Instructor at their marine training institute in lieu of a reference from shipboard personnel.

4. Proof of applicant's registration at an approved marine training institute.
5. Transcript of marks, or proof of academic achievement when upgrading nautical certification.

The successful applicants will be chosen by a scholarship selection committee who will appraise the merits and needs of the applicants in their deliberations. Captain G.O. Baugh was a founder of **The Company of Master Mariners of Canada**.

The successful candidates are required to write to the Administrator after one year, to inform them of their progress and how the award was used. Such letters may be used in the Company's newsletter or website.

Previous recipients of this scholarship will not be considered.

**Note: This year, two scholarships valued at \$3,000.00 each will be awarded nationally.**
