AWARD DESCRIPTION:

- One award will be granted annually from each of the two categories below. Should there be no suitable submission for one of the categories, then two awards will be granted from the same category.
- Should an applicant submit for both categories, they are advised their answers to each category will be considered separately by the sub-committee. **Applications not clearly separating category answers will not be considered.**
- Submissions are to be typed.
- Applicants are to check the category (categories) that apply.

CATEGORY A:

I would like to be considered for a Genoa Value Award based on me having been successful in **overcoming exceptional challenges** through displaying one (or more) of Genoa's core values of *Put People First, Create Lasting Relationships, Make a Difference, Own It, Live Well, and Never Stand Still*. I understand this could include me overcoming challenges faced such as a career move, family/personal circumstances, financial situation, personal health, etc. Applicants are to clearly demonstrate how the identified core value(s) assisted them in successfully overcoming the challenge(s). (Submit Max 1500 words titled **CATEGORY A**).

CATEGORY B:

I would like to be considered for a Genoa Value Award based on how I display one (or more) of Genoa's core values of *Put People First, Create Lasting Relationships, Make a Difference, Own It, Live Well, and Never Stand Still* in my **community involvement, volunteerism, and community spirit**. I understand this could include involvement with organizations, giving back to students/ peers, and generally what I do in support of better/ healthier/stronger community. *Applicants are to clearly demonstrate how the identified core value(s) assisted them in making more meaningful impacts in their community efforts.* (Submit Max 1500 words titled **CATEGORY B**.)

Applications must also include a letter of reference, representing **one** of the following categories:

- Work reference: Employer or representative from the Office of Career Integrated Learning at the Marine Institute
- Community reference: a community organization, peer or faculty/administration at MI

Please note, references should be advised that letters of reference should be specific to the applicant's significant experience demonstrating values of: *Put People First, Create Lasting Relationships, Make a Difference, Own It, Live Well, and Never Stand Still.*
