- Applicants should be eligible for scholarships as outlined in the Marine Institute Scholarship guidelines.

Nomination should include:

- Applicants are asked to submit a written description of their project.
- The written component of the submission can include a description of the project. The purpose of the project and description of why the chosen for of media was used.
- Applicants should also submit the project itself. Applicants are not limited to certain types of media.
